

Recommended Study Plan

BA(Hons), BSc(Hons), BPsySci(Hons)

All students are required to complete 16 units.

Full-Time Study

You will need to enrol in either PSYC4071 Individual Research Thesis or PSYC4092 Group Supervised Thesis as per your offer/progression confirmation. The thesis is a year-long 8 unit course taken over two consecutive semesters and can **only** be started in Semester 1 and must be completed in Semester 2. You must enrol in this course in both semesters. In addition you will need to take #5 units of compulsory core courses. PSYC4050 (#2 units) and PSYC4060 (#1 unit) are only offered in semester 1, whilst PSYC4121 (#2 unit) is only offered in semester 2. You must then take an additional #3 units of elective courses, comprising 1 #2 unit elective course and 1 #1 unit elective seminar course.

You may take both elective and seminar course in Semester 1 if your previous semester GPA is greater than 4.5. The school does NOT recommend undertaking your elective and seminar course in Semester 2 so that you can manage the work load to complete and submit your thesis. **Seminar Topics will be available at Orientation and enrolment via mysinet will occur after Orientation is complete.**

Part-Time Study

In Year 1 you undertake #4 units of compulsory core courses -- PSYC4050 (#2 units) in Semester 1 and PSYC4121 (#2 units) in Semester 2. We also recommend that you take your elective courses in your first year. Specifically you should enrol in one #2 unit elective course and #1 unit elective seminar course. The school recommends you take one elective course per semester.

In Year 2 you then enrol in PSYC4071 or PSYC4092 which is the #8 unit research thesis. The thesis is a year-long two semester course which can **only** be started in Semester 1 and must be completed in the consecutive Semester 2. You must enrol in this course in both semesters. In addition you will need to enrol in PSYC4060 which is a #1 unit compulsory core unit in Semester 1 of your second year.

Seminar Topics will be available at Orientation and enrolment via mysinet will occur after Orientation is complete.

Bachelor of Psychological Science – Pass Stream Students (PSYC4091) Study Plan

All students are required to complete 16 units.

You will need to enrol in PSYC4091 Group Supervised Thesis which is the #6 unit thesis. The thesis is a year-long two semester course which can **only** be started in Semester 1 and must be completed in the consecutive Semester 2. You must enrol in this course in both semesters. In addition you will need to take #5 units of compulsory core courses. PSYC4050 (#2 units) and PSYC4060 (#1 unit) are only offered in semester 1, whilst PSYC4121 (#2 unit) is only offered in semester 2.

You must then take an additional #5 units of elective courses, comprising TWO #2 unit elective course and 1 #1 unit elective seminar course. You **must** take one #2 unit elective course per semester.

Pass Stream- Part-Time Study

In Year 1 you take #4 units of compulsory core courses -- PSYC4050 (#2 units) in Semester 1 and PSYC4121 (#2 units) in Semester 2. We also recommend that you take one #2 unit elective course each semester in your first year, you can take your #1 unit elective seminar course in either Semester 1 or 2 of your first year or do this in your second year of study.

In Year 2 you should enrol in PSYC4091 which is the #6 unit group thesis. The thesis is a year-long two semester course which can only be started in Semester 1 and must be completed in the consecutive Semester 2. You must enrol in this course in both semesters. In addition you will need to enrol in PSYC4060 which is a #1 unit compulsory core unit in Semester 1 of your second year. You can then take your 1 unit seminar course in wither semester if not completed.

Seminar Topics will be available at Orientation and enrolment via mysinet will occur after Orientation is complete.
